Subject: Critical redistricting message Dear Alameda county board of supervisors, PLEASE do not let the redistricting lines remove one of our two votes on the board of supervisors! We need at least two supervisors representing the unincorporated area as we do now. Ideally, we would like to have three supervisors with avested interest in our Eden unincorporated area. Having the support of two supervisors has been critical in our achievements towards equity for our Eden area. If we lose one of our two votes by having all of the unincorporated area represented by only one supervisor, it will be a big step backward in the gains for the influence of our people that we have finally been able to establish over the course of the last two or three years. We were able to establish two more municipal advisory councils. But if we only have the representation and support of only one supervisor with their vote, their staff, and their funding, our voices will be significantly weakened and will undoubtedly cause many of our agenda items to reach a dead end at the board of supervisors. This would be a grave injustice, not only to the multitude of people who have worked for more than a decade to get us to this point, it will be a grave injustice for the generations that follow us here in the Eden area. If we can't also have representation from a third supervisor, then map "A" is the only alternative that will keep the political rug from being pulled out from underneath us. Thank you.
