1. Tri-Valley: Pleasanton, Dublin, Livermore, Sunol
2. Tri-Cities: Fremont, Newark, Union City
3. Central: Hayward, San Lorenzo, San Leandro, Castro Valley
4. Core: Alameda, Oakland (except North Oakland)
5. North: North Oakland, Piedmont, Berkeley, Emeryville, Albany
