Dear Supervisors,

On behalf of the City of Livermore, I write to express support for County redistricting draft map A-2. We recognize that the Board has a unique and challenging responsibility but believe that the Tri-Valley meets the criteria to be considered a Community of Interest, and that our boundaries should be respected during the County's redistricting process.

The Tri-Valley cities of Dublin, Livermore, Pleasanton, and the surrounding open space and semi-rural communities share a common identity and spirit among its residents. We depend on the same transportation networks, we have similar demographics and sources of employment, businesses have formed partnerships throughout the area, our children play in the same sports leagues, and our local governments collaborate on a multitude of regional projects. It makes sense to keep our communities together in the same district.

In summary, we urge you to approve draft map A-2, which keeps the Tri-Valley together as a Community of Interest. It is imperative we be included within a single district and not divided for purposes of effective and fair representation.
